R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION T-14628. US WEST CELLULAR OF CALIFORNIA,
EXECUTIVE ORDER AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF A CELL SITE
IN THE SAN DIEGO CELLULAR GEOGRAPHIC SERVICE AREA.

BY ADVICE LETTER NO. 57, FILED ON SEPTEMBER 6, 1991.

SUMMARY

US WEST CELLULAR OF CALIFORNIA (US WEST), by Advice Letter No. 57, filed on September 6, 1991, requests authority under the provisions of General Order 159 (G.O. 159) and Decision No. 90-03-080 (March 28, 1990) to add a cellular radiotelephone cell site to its existing cellular system serving the San Diego Cellular Geographic Service Area. This Resolution authorizes the construction of the cell site, known as the Five Points site, located at 2750 Kettner Blvd., San Diego. No protests to this Advice Letter have been received.

BACKGROUND

Under G.O. 159 (D.90-03-080), a cellular utility must obtain authorization from the Commission before construction of cellular facilities not described in the decision granting the certificate of public convenience and necessity. A cellular utility must file an advice letter requesting authorization to construct after it has received all approvals for the proposed construction required by any governmental agencies with jurisdiction over the proposed construction, or which would have jurisdiction absent the Commission's preemption.

DISCUSSION

Advice Letter No. 57 contains all the information required under G.O. 159 to be included in an Advice Letter filing for authority to construct additional cellular facilities.

The Five Points site represents an additional cellular radiotelephone facility not described in Decision 85-12-023, granting US WEST a certificate of public convenience and necessity.

US WEST has obtained permits or approvals from the following governmental entities and asserts that these entities comprise all governmental entities that have jurisdiction over the proposed construction (with the exception of the California Public Utilities Commission); the Federal Aviation Administration, the Federal Communication Commission, and the City of San Diego.

The proposed construction will be located at 2750 Kettner Blvd., San Diego and is known as the Five Points site. It will consist of a 12 x 30 foot prefabricated building housing communication equipment and 12 cellular antennas on a triangular platform mounted to the roof of an existing building.

The Five Points site will become part of US WEST's cellular system serving the San Diego Cellular Geographic Service Area.

NOTICE

Public notice that US WEST CELLULAR OF CALIFORNIA filed Advice Letter No. 57 requesting authority to construct the Five Points site appeared in the California Public Utilities Commission's September 11, 1991 Daily Calendar. In addition, copies of US WEST's Advice Letter No. 57 were mailed in accordance with the Commission's General Order No. 96-A, Section III. G, to competing utilities either privately or publicly owned, adjacent utilities either privately or publicly owned, utilities having requested such notification, and other interested parties having requested such notification.

PROTESTS

No protests have been received to US WEST's Advice Letter No. 57.

FINDINGS

1. On September 6, 1991, US WEST CELLULAR OF CALIFORNIA filed Advice Letter No. 57 requesting Electric Utility authorization to construct Five Points site located at 2750 Kettner Blvd., San Diego.
2. The Five Points site represents an additional cellular radiotelephone facility not described in Decision 85-12-023, granting US WEST a certificate of public convenience and necessity.
3. Decision 90-03-080 adopts G.O. 159 which sets forth certain requirements for the filing of advice letters requesting authorization to construct cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in a utility's certificate of public convenience and necessity.



4. Advice Letter No. 57 conforms to the requirements of Decision 90-03-080 and G.O. 159.
5. A US WEST officer signed a declaration which states that US WEST has received all necessary permits or approvals from the governmental entities listed in Advice Letter No. 57.
6. Advice Letter No. 57 lists the following entities which have jurisdiction over the proposed construction of the Five Points site: the Federal Aviation Administration, the Federal Communication Commission, and the City of San Diego.
7. No protests to Advice Letter No. 57 have been received.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- (1) US WEST CELLULAR OF CALIFORNIA's Advice Letter No. 57 is hereby approved.
- (2) The effective date of this resolution is October 7, 1991.
