R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION T-14767. PACTEL CELLULAR. EXECUTIVE ORDER
AUTHORIZING THE ADDITION OF A CELL SITE IN THE SAN DIEGO
METROPOLITAN AREA.

BY ADVICE LETTER NO. 81, FILED ON DECEMBER 4, 1991.

SUMMARY

PACTEL CELLULAR (PTC), by Advice Letter No. 81, filed on December 4, 1991, requests authority under the provisions of General Order 159 (G.O. 159) and Decision No. 90-03-080 (March 28, 1990) to add a cellular radiotelephone cell site to its existing cellular system serving the San Diego metropolitan area. This Resolution authorizes the construction of the cell site, known as the Highway 78 site, located at 999 Linda Vista Drive, San Marcos. No protests to this Advice Letter have been received.

BACKGROUND

Under G.O. 159 (D.90-03-080), a cellular utility must obtain authorization from the Commission before construction of cellular facilities not described in the decision granting the certificate of public convenience and necessity. A cellular utility must file an advice letter requesting authorization to construct after it has received all approvals for the proposed construction required by any governmental agencies with jurisdiction over the proposed construction, or which would have jurisdiction absent the Commission's preemption.

DISCUSSION

Advice Letter No. 81 contains all the information required under G.O. 159 to be included in an Advice Letter filing for authority to construct additional cellular facilities.

The Highway 78 site represents an additional cellular radiotelephone facility not described in Decision 85-04-023, granting PTC a certificate of public convenience and necessity.

PTC has obtained permits or approvals from the following governmental entities and asserts that these entities comprise all governmental entities that have jurisdiction over the proposed construction (with the exception of the California Public Utilities Commission): City of San Marcos, Federal Communications Commission, Federal Aviation Administration.

The proposed construction will be located at 999 Linda Vista Drive, San Marcos and is known as the Highway 78 site. It will consist of a platform with 15 cellular antennas, 4 whip antennas, and a microwave dish mounted on a 50' pole, combined height not to exceed 60'. Cellular communications equipment to be installed in an existing one story building.

The Highway 78 site will become part of PTC's cellular system serving the San Diego metropolitan area.

NOTICE

Public notice that PACTEL CELLULAR filed Advice Letter No. 81 requesting authority to construct the Highway 78 site appeared in the California Public Utilities Commission's December 6, 1991 Daily Calendar. In addition, copies of PTC's Advice Letter No. 81 were mailed in accordance with the Commission's General Order No. 96-A, Section III. G, to competing utilities either privately or publicly owned, adjacent utilities either privately or publicly owned, utilities having requested such notification, and other interested parties having requested such notification.

PROTESTS

No protests have been received to PTC's Advice Letter No. 81.

FINDINGS

1. On December 4, 1991, PACTEL CELLULAR filed Advice Letter No. 81 requesting Executive authorization to construct Highway 78 site located at 999 Linda Vista Drive, San Marcos.
2. The Highway 78 site represents an additional cellular radiotelephone facility not described in Decision 85-04-023, granting PTC a certificate of public convenience and necessity.
3. Decision 90-03-080 adopts G.O. 159 which sets forth certain requirements for the filing of advice letters requesting authorization to construct cellular radiotelephone facilities not described in a utility's certificate of public convenience and necessity.



4. Advice Letter No. 81 conforms to the requirements of Decision 90-03-080 and G.O. 159.
5. A PTC officer signed a declaration which states that PTC has received all necessary permits or approvals from the governmental entities listed in Advice Letter No. 81.
6. Advice Letter No. 81 lists the following entities which have jurisdiction over the proposed construction of the Highway 78 site: City of San Marcos, Federal Communications Commission, Federal Aviation Administration.
7. No protests to Advice Letter No. 81 have been received.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- (1) PACTEL CELLULAR's Advice Letter No. 81 is hereby approved.
- (2) The effective date of this resolution is January 6, 1992.
