RESOLUTION T-14917. CELLISYS, INC., AMNEX (CALIFORNIA), INC., AND NATIONAL PAY TELEPHONE CORPORATION OF CALIFORNIA. REQUESTS TO WITHDRAW SERVICE AND TO HAVE THE CERTIFICATES OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REVOKED.

SUMMARY

This Resolution gives to Cellisys, Inc., Amnex (California), Inc., a subsidiary of Amnex, Inc. (IEC-5138) and National Pay Telephone Corporation of California (NPTCC), also a subsidiary of Amnex, Inc. authority to withdraw their cellular resale services in the following service areas:

- 1) Cellisys, Inc. (U-4045-C) in the Napa, Fairfield, and Vallejo areas;
- 2) Amnex (California), Inc. (U-4052-C) in the Los Angeles Cellular Service Area (LA-CGSA); and
- 3) NPTCC (U-4033-C) also in the LA-CGSA.

BACKGROUND

On October 17, 1986, Cellisys, Inc. (formerly known as CAWC, Inc.) filed Application (A.) 86-10-049 requesting authority to operate as a cellular reseller in the Napa, Fairfield, and Vallejo areas. On April 17, 1987, Amnex (California), Inc. filed A.87-04-029 requesting authority to operate as a cellular reseller in the LA-CGSA. And on October 23, 1985, NPTCC filed A.85-10-039 requesting authority to operate as a cellular reseller in the LA-CGSA. The Commission determined that Cellisys, Inc.'s, Amnex (California), Inc.'s, and NPTCC's proposed operations were economically feasible, would not have significant effects on the environment, and were in the public's interest.

The Commission granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPC&N) and Corporate Identification Number to each company in the following Decisions:

On February 26, 1992, Cellisys, Inc. indicated, via Advice Letter No. 11, that they are no longer operating as a cellular reseller, that they have no customers, and that they desire to withdraw from offering service. Also on February 26, 1992, Annex, Inc., parent company of Annex (California), Inc. and NPTCC indicated, through respective Advice Letters, that Annex (California) and NPTCC are no longer operating as cellular resellers, have no customers, and desire to withdraw from offering service.

NOTICE/PROTESTS

Notice of these Advice Letters appeared on the Commission's Daily Calendar of February 28, 1992. There are no protests to these Advice Letters.

DISCUSSION

Under General Order No. 96-A, Section XIV, a utility can withdraw its services only upon Commission approval. Section XIV states:

"No public utility of a class specified herein shall, unless authority has been obtained from the Commission, either withdraw entirely from public service or withdraw from public service in any portion of the territory served."

By filing their respective Advice Letters, Cellisys, Inc., Annex (California), Inc., and NPTCC appropriately requested that their authorities be withdrawn. The Commission approves their requests and revokes their Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity.

FINDINGS

1. By Decision 87-04-017, Cellisys, Inc. was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a cellular reseller in the Napa, Fairfield, and Vallejo areas.
2. By Decision 87-08-011, Annex (California), Inc. was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a cellular reseller in the LA-CGSA.
3. By Decision 86-03-020, NPTCC was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a cellular reseller in the LA-CGSA.

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4. By Advice Letters dated February 26, 1992, Cellisys, Inc., Annex (California), Inc., and NPTCC request to withdraw services authorized by Decisions cited in Findings 1, 2, and 3 respectively.

5. Cellisys, Inc., Annex (California), Inc., and NPTCC have no customers.

THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED that:


1. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity previously granted to Cellisys, Inc. is revoked, and its tariffs are cancelled. Its CPUC Corporate Identification Number U-4045-C is also cancelled and will not be reissued.

2. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity previously granted to Annex (California), Inc. is revoked, and its tariffs are cancelled. Its CPUC Corporate Identification Number U-4052-C is also cancelled and will not be reissued.

3. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity previously granted to NPTCC is revoked, and its tariffs are cancelled. Its CPUC Corporate Identification Number U-4033-C is also cancelled and will not be reissued.

4. A copy of this resolution shall be placed in the Commission's formal files for Applications 86-10-049, 87-04-029, and 85-10-039.
