BESQLUTION

RESOLUTION T-15038. U. S. OPERATORS, INC. REQUEST TO HAVE ITS CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REVOKED.

BY ADVICE LETTER 10, FILED ON JUNE 19, 1992.

SUMMARY

U. S. Operators, Inc. (U-5174-C), by Advice Letter No. 10, dated June 19, 1992, requests authority under the provisions of General Order 96-A, Section XIV, to withdraw from service as an Interexchange Carrier.

BACKGROUND

U. S. Operators, Inc. was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) by Decision (D.) 89-04-031 on April 12, 1989 to operate as a nondominant interexchange carrier (NDIEC).

U. S. Operators' former customers have all chosen another carrier for long distance telephone service; therefore, no customer will be affected by U. S. Operators' withdrawal of service.

PROTESTS

Notice of this Advice Letter appeared on the Commission's Daily Calendar on June 23, 1992. No protests of the Advice Letter have been filed.

DISCUSSION

Under General order 96-A, Section XIV, a utility may not withdraw from service without Commission authorization. Section XIV reads as follows:

"No public utility of a class specified herein shall, unless authority has been obtained from the Commission, either withdraw entirely from public service or withdraw from public service in any portion of the territory Resolution T-15038 U. S. Operators, Inc.

U. S. Operators, Inc. properly requested that authorization through the filing of Advice Letter No. 10.

1. U.S. Operators, Inc. was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a nondominant interexchange carrier in Decision 89-04-031.

2. U. S. Operators, Inc. submitted Advice Letter No. 10 requesting authority to withdraw from service as a nondominant interexchange carrier.

3. U. S. Operators, Inc. has no customers. All its former customers have been transferred to another carrier for long distance telephone services.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity previously granted to U.S. Operators, Inc. is revoked.

2. A copy of this resolution shall be placed in the Commission's formal files for Application No. 88-10-026.

3. U. S. Operators, Inc.'s nondominant interexchange carrier tariffs are cancelled. The CPUC Corporate Identification Number U-5174-C is also cancelled and will not be reissued.

The effective date of this resolution is today.
