R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION T-15590. REQUEST OF ASCOM COMMUNICATIONS INC. TO HAVE ITS CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REVOKED.

SUMMARY

Ascom Communications Inc., by letter received April 27, 1995, requests authority to withdraw from service as a nondominant interexchange carrier. This Resolution revokes the company's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity. It has no customers.

BACKGROUND

Ascom Communications Inc. was granted its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) by D.90-05-063 in May, 1990, to operate as a nondominant interexchange and alternative operator service (AOS) carrier. Its tariff was filed on February 14, 1991, and was made effective on March 26, 1991. Subsequently, it was acquired by Peoples Telephone Company. The company currently has no customers; therefore, no customers will be affected by this action.

DISCUSSION

Ascom Communications Inc. sent a letter to the Commission that was received on April 27, 1995, in which the company requested revocation of Ascom Communications Inc.'s CPCN. The Commission Advisory and Compliance Division recommends that the company's CPCN be revoked and that its Corporate Identification Number be cancelled.

FINDINGS

1. Ascom Communications Inc. was granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a nondominant interexchange carrier and alternative operator service provider in D.90-05-063.
2. Ascom Communications Inc. requested revocation of its CPCN by letter received on April 27, 1995. The Commission should cancel the company's Corporate Identification Number at the same time.


3. Ascom Communications Inc. has no customers; therefore, no customers will be affected by this action.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity previously granted to Ascom Communications Inc. is revoked.
2. A copy of this Resolution shall be placed in the Commission's formal files for Application No. 89-10-058.
3. Ascom Communications Inc.'s CPUC Corporate Identification Number, U-5204-C, is also cancelled and will not be reissued.
