R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION T-15774. REQUEST OF ENTERPRISE TELECOM SERVICES, INC. TO HAVE ITS CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REVOKED.

SUMMARY

Enterprise Telecom Services, Inc., by letter dated July 10, 1995, requests authority to withdraw from service as a nondominant interexchange carrier (NDIEC). This Resolution revokes the company's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN). The company has no current customers; therefore, no customers will be inconvenienced by the company's withdrawal of service.

BACKGROUND

Enterprise Telecom Services, Inc. was granted its CPCN by D.93-01-039 effective on January 22, 1993, to operate as an NDIEC. Its tariff was filed on March 24, 1993, and made effective on March 25, 1993.

DISCUSSION

Enterprise Telecom Services, Inc. informed the Commission by letter dated July 10, 1995, that it is no longer acting as an NDIEC. The Commission Advisory and Compliance Division recommends that the CPCN be revoked as requested and that the Corporate Identification Number (U-5302-C) be cancelled.

FINDINGS

1. Enterprise Telecom Services, Inc. was granted a CPCN as a nondominant interexchange carrier by Decision 93-01-039.
2. The company requests revocation of its CPCN by letter dated July 10, 1995.
3. The company's CPCN should be revoked. Its Corporate Identification Number should be cancelled.


THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity previously granted to Enterprise Telecom Services, Inc. is revoked.
2. A copy of this Resolution shall be placed in the Commission's formal files for Application No.92-09-012.
3. The company's California Public Utilities Commission Corporate Identification Number, U-5302-C, is cancelled and will not be reissued.
