R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION T-15870, REQUEST OF SCG FINANCIAL CORPORATION
(dba PARAGON COMMUNICATIONS) TO HAVE ITS CERTIFICATE OF
PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REVOKED.

SUMMARY

SCG Financial Corporation, Inc. (dba Paragon Communications, Inc.), by letter dated January 15, 1996, informed the Commission that it has withdrawn from all operations in California as a non-dominant interexchange carrier (NDIEC). This Resolution revokes the company's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN). The company has no current customers, therefore, no customers will be inconvenienced by the company's withdrawal of service.

BACKGROUND

Paragon Communications was granted its CPCN by D.92-08-008 effective on August 11, 1992 to operate as an NDIEC. Its tariff was filed on September 14, 1992, and made effective on September 15, 1992.

DISCUSSION

Paragon Communications informed the Commission by letter dated January 15, 1996, that it is no longer acting as an NDIEC. The Commission Advisory and Compliance Division recommends that the CPCN be revoked as requested and that the Corporate Identification Number (U-5281-C) be cancelled.

FINDINGS

1. Paragon Communications was granted a CPCN as a nondominant interexchange carrier by Decision 92-08-008.
2. The company informed the Commission of its cessation of telecommunications operations by letter dated January 15, 1996.

3. The company's CPCN should be revoked. Its Corporate Identification number should be cancelled

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity previously granted to Paragon Communications, Inc. is revoked.

2. A copy of this Resolution shall be placed in the Commission's formal files for Application No.91-09-029.

3. The company's California Public Utilities Commission Corporate Identification Number, U-5281-C, is cancelled and will not be reissued.

The effective date of this Resolution is today.
