RESOLUTION T-15874, REVOCATION OF THE CERTIFICATE OF
PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY FOR DOWNER
COMMUNICATIONS, INC.

SUMMARY

This resolution revokes the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) for Downer Communications, Inc. (U-4065-C), which has had authority to operate as a cellular reseller since May 25, 1988. The company apparently has no current customers; therefore, no customers will be inconvenienced by the company's withdrawal of service.

BACKGROUND

Downer Communications Inc. was granted its CPCN by D.88-05-061 effective on May 25, 1988, to operate as an cellular reseller. The company has not filed any tariffs.

DISCUSSION

The following information is presented as evidence that the company is not providing and does not intend to provide service as a telecommunications utility. Our records show that Downer Communications has failed to do the following:

1. File User Fees with the Commission (required by PU Code Section 431),
2. File Universal Lifeline Service Fees (required by D.87-07-090 and D.94-09-065),
3. File Annual Financial Reports (required by General Order 104-A),
4. File California Relay and Communication Devices Fund Fees (required by D.94-09-065 and PU Code Section 2881),
5. File California High Cost Fund Fees (required by PU Code Section 739.3 and D.94-09-065), and

6. Update its tariff pages (e.g., updating the surcharge rates listed above).

Several mailings to the address of record have been returned "addressee unknown." When the telephone number of record was called, the person answering the call stated that she did not know anything about Downer Communications Inc.

FINDINGS


1. Downer Communications has not maintained its obligations as a certificated cellular reseller in California.
2. Downer Communications apparently has never had customers; therefore, no customers will be inconvenienced by the company's withdrawal of service.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity previously granted to Downer Communications is revoked.
2. A copy of this Resolution shall be placed in the Commission's formal file for Application No. 87-10-007.
3. The company's California Public Utilities Commission Corporate Identification Number, U-4065-C, is cancelled and will not be reissued.

The effective date of this Resolution is today.
