R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION T-15881, REQUEST OF LUBBOCK RADIO PAGING SERVICE, INCORPORATED (dba STENOCALL) TO HAVE ITS CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REVOKED.

SUMMARY

Lubbock Radio Paging Service, Inc. (dba Stenocall), by letter dated April 4, 1996, informed the Commission that it has withdrawn from all operations in California as a non-dominant interexchange carrier (NDIEC). This Resolution revokes the company's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN). The company has no current customers, therefore, no customers will be inconvenienced by the company's withdrawal of service.

BACKGROUND

Stenocall was granted its CPCN by D.91-11-052 effective on November 20, 1991 to operate as an NDIEC. Its tariff was filed on December 11, 1991, and made effective on December 16, 1991.

DISCUSSION

Stenocall informed the Commission by letter dated April 4, 1996, that it is no longer acting as an NDIEC. The Commission Advisory and Compliance Division recommends that the CPCN be revoked as requested and that the Corporate Identification Number (U-5247-C) be cancelled.

FINDINGS

1. Stenocall was granted a CPCN as a nondominant interexchange carrier by Decision 91-11-052.
2. The company informed the Commission of its cessation of telecommunications operations by letter dated April 4, 1996.


3. The company's CPCN should be revoked. Its Corporate Identification number should be cancelled

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity previously granted to Stenocall is revoked.
2. A copy of this Resolution shall be placed in the Commission's formal files for Application No. 91-07-045.
3. The company's California Public Utilities Commission Corporate Identification Number, U-5247-C, is cancelled and will not be reissued.

The effective date of this Resolution is today.
