R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION T-15993. REQUEST OF ITC TELE-SERVICES, INC.
TO HAVE ITS CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND
NECESSITY REVOKED.

SUMMARY

This Resolution revokes the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) of ITC Tele-Services, Inc. at the company's request. The company has no current customers; therefore, no customers will be inconvenienced by the company's withdrawal of service.

BACKGROUND

ITC Tele-Services, Inc. applied for its CPCN on May 14, 1990 under the name of International Pacific, Inc. The application was granted on August 8, 1990. The company filed a tariff with the Commission on August 20, 1990. ITC Tele-Services, Inc. transferred ownership to LDDS WorldCom, effective on August 8, 1994.

DISCUSSION

ITC Tele-Services, Inc. requested, by letter dated December 3, 1996, that its CPCN be revoked. The company no longer has its own customers in California; therefore, no customers will be inconvenienced by the revocation.

FINDINGS

1. ITC Tele-Services, Inc. was granted a CPCN as a nondominant interexchange carrier by Decision 90-08-012.
2. The company requested the revocation of its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) by letter dated December 3, 1996.
3. The company's CPCN should be revoked. Its Corporate Identification Number should be cancelled.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity previously granted to ITC Tele-Services, Inc. is revoked.
2. A copy of this Resolution shall be placed in the Commission's formal files for Application No.90-05-024.
3. The company's California Public Utilities Commission Corporate Identification Number, U-5215-C, is cancelled and will not be reissued.

The effective date of this Resolution is today.
