RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION T-16015. REQUEST OF AMERIFAX, INC. TO HAVE ITS CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REVOKED.

SUMMARY

Amerifax, Inc., by Advice Letter No. 2 (dated November 1, 1996), has requested that the Commission revoke its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN). This Resolution grants the company's request.

BACKGROUND

Amerifax, Inc. was granted its CPCN by D.92-09-006, effective on September 2, 1992, to operate as a non-dominant interexchange carrier (NDIEC). Its tariff was filed on October 28, 1992, and made effective on November 1, 1992.

DISCUSSION

Amerifax, Inc. informed the Commission by Advice Letter No. 2 (dated November 1, 1996), that it has merged with Phoenix Network, another NDIEC. The company requested that its CPCN be revoked. All its customers have been transferred to Phoenix Network; therefore, no customer will be inconvenienced by the revocation. The Telecommunications Division recommends that the CPCN be revoked as requested and that the Corporate Identification Number be cancelled.

FINDINGS

- 1. Amerifax, Inc. was granted a CPCN as a nondominant interexchange carrier by Decision No. 92-09-006.
- 2. The company requested that the Commission revoke its CPCN in Advice Letter No. 2.
- 3. No customers will be inconvenienced by the revocation of the company's CPCN.

4. The company's CPCN should be revoked. Its Corporate Identification Number should be cancelled.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity previously granted to Amerifax, Inc. is revoked.
- 2. A copy of this Resolution shall be placed in the Commission's formal files for Application No. 91-05-043.
- 3. The company's California Public Utilities Commission Corporate Identification Number, U-5283-C, is cancelled and will not be reissued.

The effective date of this Resolution is today.
