R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION T-16019. REQUEST OF XLCONNECT SERVICES, INC.
TO HAVE ITS CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND
NECESSITY REVOKED.

SUMMARY

XLConnect Services, Inc., by letter dated March 17, 1997, informed the Commission that it has withdrawn from all operations in California as a nondominant interexchange carrier (NDIEC). This Resolution revokes the company's Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN). The company has no current customers; therefore, no customers will be inconvenienced by the company's withdrawal of service.

BACKGROUND

XLConnect Services, Inc. applied for a CPCN under the name of Intellicom Solutions, Inc. in June 1995. The CPCN was granted on October 18, 1995, by D.95-10-044. The company filed its tariff on March 11, 1996, and it became effective on April 15, 1996.

DISCUSSION

XLConnect Services, Inc. informed the Commission, by letter dated March 17, 1997, that it is no longer acting as an NDIEC. The Telecommunications Division recommends that the CPCN be revoked as requested and that the Corporate Identification Number be cancelled.

FINDINGS


1. XLConnect Services, Inc. was granted a CPCN as a nondominant interexchange carrier by Decision 95-10-044.
2. The company informed the Commission of its cessation of telecommunications operations by letter dated March 17, 1997.
3. The company's CPCN should be revoked. Its Corporate Identification Number should be cancelled.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity previously granted to XLConnect Services, Inc. is revoked.
2. A copy of this Resolution shall be placed in the Commission's formal files for Application No.95-06-044.
3. The company's California Public Utilities Commission Corporate Identification Number, U-5530-C, is cancelled and will not be reissued.

The effective date of this Resolution is today.
