R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION T-16064. REQUEST OF AMERICAN CELLULAR RENTAL, INC. TO HAVE ITS AUTHORIZATION TO PROVIDE CELLULAR RESELLER SERVICE REVOKED. (U-4174-C)

SUMMARY

American Cellular Rental, Inc. requested authority, by letter dated February 6, 1997, to withdraw from service as a reseller of cellular service in California. This Resolution revokes the company's authority to provide cellular reseller service. The company has no customers.

BACKGROUND

American Cellular Rental, Inc. registered with the Commission and was granted authority to operate as a cellular reseller by letter dated April 19, 1996. Its tariff was filed on May 22, 1996, and made effective on May 27, 1996. The company ceased operations on December 31, 1996.

DISCUSSION

American Cellular Rental, Inc. informed the Commission by letter, dated February 6, 1997, that it is no longer acting as a cellular reseller. The Telecommunications Division recommends that the CPCN be revoked as requested and that the Corporate Identification Number (U-4174-C) be cancelled.

FINDINGS

1. American Cellular Rental, Inc.'s registration as a cellular reseller was confirmed by letter dated April 19, 1996.
2. The company requested revocation of its authority by letter dated February 6, 1997..
3. The company's authority should be revoked. Its Corporate Identification Number should be cancelled.



2. The company's California Public Utilities Commission Corporate Identification Number, U-4174-C, is cancelled and will not be reissued.
