R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION T-16183. U.S. VOICE, INC., dba PACIFIC VOICE (U-5579-C). REVOCATION OF CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY.

SUMMARY

This Resolution revokes the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity of Pacific Voice, as requested by the company.

BACKGROUND

U.S. Voice, Inc., dba Pacific Voice, filed for its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) as a nondominant interexchange carrier in Application 95-08-042. Authority was granted in Decision 96-02-041. The company filed its tariff on June 28, 1996, and the tariff became effective on October 12, 1996.

The company informed its customers of upcoming service termination at least 30 days prior to ceasing operations.

DISCUSSION

The company sent a letter to the Commission on April 13, 1998, in which it requested that its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity be revoked. There is no reason to deny this request since there are numerous competitors to the company in the long distance market.

Telecommunications Division recommends that the request for revocation be granted and that the Utility Identification Number be cancelled.

FINDINGS

1. Pacific Voice obtained its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) in Decision 96-02-031.
2. The company requested that its CPCN be cancelled in a letter to the Commission dated April 13, 1998.

3. The company's CPCN should be revoked and its Utility Identification Number should be cancelled.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity formerly granted to U.S. Voice, Inc., dba Pacific Voice is revoked.
2. The company's Utility Identification Number (U-5579-C) is cancelled and will not be reissued.

This Resolution is effective today.
