
GRANTING AN EXEMPTION FROM GENERAL ORDER 72-B TO PERMIT THE INSTALLATION OF A RUBBER GRADE CROSSING SURFACE AT THE VINEYARD AVENUE CROSSING OF THE ATCHISON, TOPEKA, AND SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY'S TRACKS, CROSSING 2-98.7 IN RANCHO CUCAMONGA, SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY.

The City of Rancho Cucamonga (City) by letter dated January 5, 1989, has requested that it be granted an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit the installation of a rubber grade crossing surface at the Vineyard Avenue crossing of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company's (AT&SF) tracks, Crossing 2-98.7 in Rancho Cucamonga, San Bernardino County. Installation of the rubber grade crossing surface will improve the durability and riding quality of the crossing.

AT&SF indicated it has no opposition to the requested exemption.

IT IS RESOLVED that the City of Rancho Cucamonga is granted an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit the installation of a rubber grade crossing surface at the Vineyard Avenue crossing of The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company's tracks, Crossing 2-98.7 in Rancho Cucamonga, San Bernardino County.

This resolution issued pursuant to Resolution ET-1368 and is effective today, JANUARY 23, 1989.
