R E S O L U T I O N

GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO COMPLETE CONSTRUCTION  
OF A RAILROAD CROSSING AT GRADE ACROSS THE TRACKS OF  
THE SOUTHERN PACIFIC TRANSPORTATION COMPANY'S  
DECLEZVILLE BRANCH LINE IN THE CITY OF FONTANA,  
SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY

By letter dated January 13, 1989, the City of Fontana has requested an extension of time to comply with Decision (D.) 88-01-028 dated January 28, 1988, in Application (A.) 85-05-078 which authorized the construction of a grade crossing at Santa Ana Avenue at-grade across Southern Pacific Transportation Company's (SPT) Declezville Branch Line, in Fontana, San Bernardino County, to be identified as Crossing No. BBH - 530.5.

SPT has indicated it has no objection to the requested extension of time. The staff finds that there have been no substantial changes in circumstances since the original authority was granted.

IT IS RESOLVED that the City of Fontana is granted an extension of time until January 4, 1991, to exercise the authority granted by D. 88-01-028. In all other respects D.88-01-028 shall remain in full force and effect.

This resolution is issued pursuant to Resolution ET-1367 and memorandum by the Executive Director dated April 6, 1988, and is effective today, March 14, 1989.
