
GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO COMPLETE CONSTRUCTION  
OF A RAILROAD CROSSING AT-GRADE IN THE COUNTY OF LOS  
ANGELES.

By letter dated November 21, 1988 the County of Los Angeles (County) requested an extension of time to comply with Decision (D.) 86-11-059 which authorized the construction of Golden Valley Road at-grade across Southern Pacific Transportation Company's (SPT) track, Los Angeles County, to be identified as Crossing B-447.1.

By letter dated December 1, 1988, SPT indicated it has no objection to the requested extension of time. The staff finds that there has been no substantial change in circumstances since the original authority was granted by Commission decision.

IT IS RESOLVED that the County of Los Angeles is granted an extension of time until December 14, 1990, to exercise the authority granted by D.86-11-059 in Application 86-04-008. In all other respects, D.86-11-059 shall remain in full force and effect.

This resolution is issued pursuant to Resolution ET-1367 and memorandum by the Executive Director dated April 6, 1988, and is effective today, MAY 19, 1989
