
**GRANTING EXEMPTION TO GENERAL ORDER 72-B TO PERMIT
INSTALLATION OF RUBBER CROSSING SURFACE AT NORTH
MCDOWELL BOULEVARD CROSSING OF SOUTHERN PACIFIC
TRANSPORTATION COMPANY'S TRACKS IN THE CITY OF
PETALUMA, SONOMA COUNTY.**

By letter dated March 16, 1990 the City of Petaluma has requested an exemption from General Order (G.O.) 72-B to permit installation of a rubber crossing surface at Crossing 5-40.7, where North McDowell Boulevard crosses the tracks of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company (SPT) in Petaluma, Sonoma County.

By letter dated February 15, 1990 SPT indicated it has no opposition to the requested exemption. Installation of the rubber grade crossing surface will improve the durability and riding quality of the crossing.

IT IS RESOLVED that the City of Petaluma is granted an exemption from G.O. 72-B to permit installation of a rubber grade crossing surface at Crossing 5-40.7, where North McDowell Boulevard crosses the tracks of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company in Petaluma, Sonoma County.

This resolution is issued pursuant to Resolution ET-1368 and memorandum by the Executive Director dated April 6, 1988, and is effective today, May 30, 1990.
