R E S O L U T I O N

GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME FOR AUTHORITY TO CONSTRUCT
TWO RAILROAD CROSSINGS AT SEPARATED GRADES AT CULVER
DRIVE AND JEFFREY ROAD OVER THE ATCHISON, TOPEKA AND
SANTA FE RAILWAY COMPANY'S SAN DIEGO SUBDIVISION IN
THE CITY OF IRVINE, ORANGE COUNTY

By letter dated June 19, 1990, the City of Irvine requested an extension of time to comply with Decisions 88-04-033, 86-04-001, and 83-03-056 which authorized the construction of two crossings at separated grades at Culver Drive and Jeffrey Road over the track of The Atchison, Topeka, and Santa Fe Railway Company's (AT&SF) San Diego subdivision, in the City of Irvine, Orange County, to be identified as Crossing Nos. 2 - 180.5-A and 2 - 182.0-A, respectively.

By letter dated July 5, 1990, AT&SF indicated it had no objection to a two year extension of time.

IT IS RESOLVED that the City of Irvine is granted an extension of time until June 30, 1992, to exercise the authority granted by Decisions 88-04-033, 86-04-001, and 83-03-056. In all other respects these three decisions shall remain in full force and effect.

This resolution is issued pursuant to Resolution ET-1367 and memorandum by the Executive Director dated April 6, 1988, and is effective today, July 10, 1990.
