R E S O L U T I O N

GRANTING AN EXEMPTION FROM GENERAL ORDER 72-B TO PERMIT THE INSTALLATION OF A RUBBER GRADE CROSSING SURFACE AT TWO CORRAL HOLLOW ROAD CROSSINGS OF SOUTHERN PACIFIC TRANSPORTATION COMPANY'S TRACKS, CROSSINGS D-69.2 AND B-80.6, IN TRACY, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY.

The City of Tracy, by letter dated May 30, 1990, has requested that it be granted an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit the installation of a rubber grade crossing surface at two Corral Hollow Road crossings of Southern Pacific Transportation Company's (SPT) tracks, Crossings D-69.2 and B-80.6, in Tracy, San Joaquin County.

Installation of the rubber grade crossing surface will improve the durability and riding quality of the crossings. By letter dated May 4, 1990, SPT has approved the plans and has no objection to the proposed project. The installation would be part of a street widening and crossing protection improvement project authorized under General Order 88-A July 12, 1990.

IT IS RESOLVED that the City of Tracy is granted an exemption from General Order 72-B to permit the installation of a rubber grade crossing surface at two Corral Hollow Road crossings of Southern Pacific Transportation Company's tracks, Crossings D-69.2 and B-80.6, in Tracy, San Joaquin County.

This resolution is issued pursuant to Resolution ET-1368 and memorandum by the Executive Director dated April 6, 1988, and is effective today, August 15, 1990.
