<u>R E S O L U T I O N</u>

GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO COMPLETE CONSTRUCTION OF A SOUTHERN PACIFIC TRANSPORTATION COMPANY INDUSTRIAL DRILL TRACK AT GRADE ACROSS SLOVER AVENUE, SANTA ANA AVENUE AND DAHLIA STREET IN FONTANA, SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY.

By letter dated August 15, 1990 City of Fontana(City) requests a two year extension of time from May 13, 1990 to May 13, 1992 to comply with the provisions of Decision (D.)88-04-023, dated April 13, 1988, in Application (A.) 87-06-026, which authorized the construction of a Southern Pacific Transportation Company (SPT) industrial drill track at grade across Slover Avenue, Santa Ana Avenue and Dahlia Street in Fontana, San Bernardino County. City has advised the Commission staff that although the project is nearly completed, additional time is necessary for SPT to install the automatic crossing protection and other track items required by D.88-04-023.

SPT has indicated it has no objection to the requested extension of time. The Staff finds that there has been no substantial change of circumstances since the original authority was granted by Commission Decision.

IT IS RESOLVED that the City of Fontana is granted an extension of time from May 13, 1990 to May 13, 1992 to exercise the authority granted by D.88-04-023 in A. 87-06-026. In all other respects, D.88-04-023 shall remain in full force and effect.

This resolution is issued pursuant to Resolution ET-1367 and memorandum by the Executive Director dated April 6, 1988, and is effective today, <u>August 22, 1990</u>
