## RESQLUTION

GRANTING AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO COMPLETE CONSTRUCTION OF AN INDUSTRIAL DRILL TRACK AT GRADE ACROSS RAMONA AND NORTON AVENUES IN CHINO, SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY.

Southern Pacific Transportation Company (SPT), by letter dated January 13, 1992, requests an extension of time from February 8, 1992, to February 8, 1993, to comply with the provisions of Decision (D.) 90-01-002, dated January 9, 1990, in Application (A.) 89-07-044, which granted authority to construct an industrial drill track at grade across Ramona and Norton Avenues in Chino, San Bernardino County. The crossings are identified as Ramona Avenue, BAB - 521.82-C and Norton Avenue, BAB-522.07-C.

SPT states that due to circumstances beyond its control, the spur track has not yet been completed.

City of Chino has no objection to granting of the time extension. The Commission Staff finds that there has been no substantial change in circumstances since the original authority was granted.

IT IS RESOLVED that Southern Pacific Transportation Company is granted an extension of time from February 8, 1992 to February 8, 1993, to exercise the authority granted by D. 90-01-002 in A. 89-07-044. In all other respects, D. 90-01-002 shall remain in full force and effect.

This resolution is issued pursuant to Resolution ET-1367 and memorandum by the Executive Director dated April 6, 1988, and is effective today, <u>February 11, 1992</u>.
