GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO COMPLETE CONSTRUCTION
OF CANYON PARK BOULEVARD ACROSS THE TRACKS OF
SOUTHERN PACIFIC TRANSPORTATION COMPANY'S EL
PASO MAIN LINE IN THE SOLEMINT AREA OF LOS ANGELES
COUNTY

By letter dated February 10, 1992, Los Angeles County (County) requests a two year time extension of time, from June 25, 1992 to June 25, 1994, to comply with the provisions of Decision (D.)89-05-074, dated May 26, 1989, in Application (A.)88-12-059 which authorized construction of Canyon Park Boulevard Crossing B-444.05 across the tracks of Southern Pacific Transportation Company's El Paso Main Line in the Solemint Area of Los Angeles County.

The Southern Pacific Transportation Company (SPT) by letter dated March 3, 1992, has indicated that it has no objections to the requested extension of time. The Safety Division staff finds that there has been no substantial change in circumstances since the original authority was granted by Commission Decision.

IT IS RESOLVED that the County of Los Angeles is granted an extension of time to June 25, 1994 to exercise the authority granted by D.89-05-074 in A.88-12-059. In all other respects, D.89-05-074 shall remain in full force and effect.

This resolution is issued pursuant to Resolution ET-1367 and memorandum by the Executive Director dated April 6, 1988, and is effective today, March 11, 1992.
