
GRANTING EXEMPTION TO GENERAL ORDER 72-B TO PERMIT
INSTALLATION OF RUBBER CROSSING SURFACE AT FOUR
CROSSINGS OF SOUTHERN PACIFIC TRANSPORTATION COMPANY'S
TRACKS IN THE CITY OF OAKLAND, ALAMEDA COUNTY.

By letter dated April 24, 1988 the Port of Oakland in the City of Oakland (City) has requested an exemption from General Order (G.O.) 72-B to permit installation of rubber crossing surface sidewalks at Crossings D-6.5, D-6.6, D-6.7, and D-6.75, where Clay, Washington, Broadway, and Franklin Streets, respectively, cross the tracks of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company (SPT) in Oakland, Alameda County.

By letter dated October 29, 1987 SPT indicated it has no opposition to the requested exemption. Installation of the rubber grade crossing surface sidewalks will improve the pedestrian safety of the crossings.

IT IS RESOLVED that the City of Oakland is granted an exemption from G.O. 72-B to permit installation of rubber grade crossing surface sidewalks at Crossings D-6.5, D-6.6, D-6.7, and D-6.75, where Clay, Washington, Broadway, and Franklin Streets, respectively, cross the tracks of the Southern Pacific Transportation Company in Oakland, Alameda County.

This resolution is issued pursuant to Resolution ET-1368 and memorandum by the Executive Director dated April 6, 1988, and is effective today, JULY 5, 1988.
