
GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME TO COMPLETE CONSTRUCTION
OF A RAILROAD CROSSING AT GRADE ACROSS THE TRACKS OF
THE SOUTHERN PACIFIC TRANSPORTATION COMPANY'S MAIN
LINE, IN THE CITY OF INDUSTRY, LOS ANGELES COUNTY

The City of Industry (City), by letter dated October 20, 1988, has requested an extension of time to comply with Decision (D.) 87-09-053 and D.84-11-073 which authorized the construction of Fullerton Road at grade across the tracks of Southern Pacific Transportation Company's (SPT) El Paso main line, in City of Industry, Los Angeles County, to be identified as Crossing No. B - 503.9.

SPT has indicated it has no objections to the requested extension of time. The staff finds that there has been no substantial change in circumstances since the original authority was granted by Commission decision.

IT IS RESOLVED that the City of Industry is granted an extension of time until December 7, 1990, to exercise the authority granted by D.87-09-053 in Application (A.) 87-01-040 and D.84-11-073 in A.84-07-021. In all other respects, D.87-09-053 and D.84-11-073 shall remain in full force and effect.

This resolution is issued pursuant to Resolution ET-1367 and memorandum by the Executive Director dated April 6, 1988, and is effective today, JANUARY 9, 1989.
