## RESOLUTION REINSTATING PASSENGER STAGE CORPORATION CERTIFICATE OF KENNETH HARRELL DBA HARRELL'S TOURS , PSC-1137

Kenneth Harrell dba Harrell's Tours by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by the Commission's Decision D-92285 (A-59797) dated October 10, 1980 was authorized to operate as a passenger stage corporation to transport passengers between points in Livermore and Pleasanton on the one hand and the United Airlines Maintenance Base at the San Francisco International Airport on the other hand.

Harrell's Tours (Harrell) certificate of public convenience and necessity was suspended for lack of adequate evidence of insurance on file with the Commission on March 8, 1985. On May 10, 1985, the Commission staff revoked its passenger stage corporation authority pursuant to Commission Resolution PE-498 dated May 16, 1984.

On September 11, 1985, the staff received a certificate of insurance filing on behalf of Harrell. Staff had no policy at that time of advising carriers of receipt of a filing. On September 11, 1987, the staff received another certificate of insurance filing. Under new staff policy Harrell was advised by letter on September 22, 1987 of the filing, that they no longer had operating authority and that they would have to reapply if they wished to continue to operate.

Staff received a letter dated October 19, 1987 in which Harrell stated that they had been unaware of the revocation until receipt of the staff's letter and that they had relied on their insurance agent to see that the insurance filing requirements were met. The staff advised Harrell that if they wished to be reinstated they would have to appeal to the Commission in writing. Resolution TL-18250 Transportation Division Page 2 of 3

By letter dated January 7, 1988 Harrell appealed to the Commission for reinstatement of its passenger stage certificate and enclosed photocopies of various papers showing that they had paid for insurance coverage. Furnished also was a petition of support with 29 signatures which stated that without the service the signators would be forced to get to work by car.

This reinstatement of authority should be granted immediately because of the public need for the service. If the carrier is prevented from serving the airport because of its lack of Commission authority there will be extreme hardship on the public who rely on the service to get to work, and contribute additional highway congestion and pollution.

Under the above circumstances, the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity are best served if the Commission vacates the revocation resolution issued on Nay 10, 1985 and reinstates the carrier's revoked operating authority described above.

## ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The revocation resolution dated Nay 10, 1985 is hereby rescinded.
- 2. The authority (PSC-1137) granted to Kenneth Harrell dba Harrell's Tours is hereby reinstated.
- 3. Reinstatement of this authority may be made on the effective date of this resolution if a reinstatement fee of \$500.00 is paid to the Commission.
