RESOLUTION GRANTING VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION OF THE PASSENGER STAGE CORPORATION CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY HELD BY MOUNT REBA, INC., PSC 986

Mount Reba, Inc. of Bear Valley, California holds a certificate of public convenience and necessity as a passenger stage corporation (PSC 986) for the transportation of passengers and their baggage between Bear Valley and Mt. Reba Ski Area in Alpine County. The certificate was acquired pursuant to Decision 85485 dated February 18, 1976 in Application 56054.

On May 20, 1988 Mt. Reba, Inc. requested voluntary suspension of PSC 986 to allow them to cancel their insurance coverage during the summer months when they do not operate.

In these circumstances, the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity do not require the service of this carrier at this time.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity as a passenger stage corporation (PSC 986) which was acquired by Mt. Reba, Inc. pursuant to Decision 85485, dated February 18, 1986, in Application 56054, is hereby suspended until June 8, 1989.
2. Mt. Reba, Inc. is authorized and directed to issue suspension supplements to the tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission.

3. Prior to the resumption of service, a request for reinstatement shall be made in writing, and tariff and timetable supplements cancelling the suspension shall be filed. The required filings shall be made on not less than five days notice to the public and to the Commission.
4. The authority to suspend operations granted herein shall expire on June 8, 1989 or upon earlier resumption of service, which may be effected upon compliance with the Ordering Paragraph 3 above.
5. Mt. Reba, Inc. is placed on notice that commencement of operations under the certificate referred to herein prior to compliance with Ordering Paragraphs 3 and 4 may be cause for further suspension, or revocation, of its operating authority.
