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## RESOLUTION

## RESOLUTION GRANTING VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION OF PASSENGER STAGE CORPORATION CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY HELD BY ABRAHAM NEWHAN, PSC-1465.

Abraham Newman (Newman) holds a certificate of public convenience and necessity as a passenger stage corporation (PSC-1465) for the transportation of passengers and their baggage between points in the City of San Francisco, on the one hand, and Sausalito, on the other hand.

On September 27, 1988 Newman requested voluntary suspension of PSC-1465. He could not continue to operate since an emergency caused by the death of a relative made it necessary for him to leave the United States for several months. Several alternate means of public transportation between San Francisco and Sausalito are available.

Under the circumstances, the Commission finds that public convenience and necessity do not require the service of this carrier at this time.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Abraham Newman is hereby suspended for the period of one year commencing on the effective date of this resolution. Resolution TL 18264 Transportation Division Page 2 of 2

- Newman is authorized and directed to file suspension supplements to the tariffs and timetables on file with the Commission.
- 3. Prior to the resumption of service, tariff and tinetable supplements cancelling the suspension supplements shall be filed. The required filing shall be made on not less than five days notice to the public and to the Commission.
- 4. The authority to suspend operation granted herein shall expire one year from the effective date of this resolution or upon earlier resumption of service, which may be accomplished through compliance with Ordering Paragraph 3 above.
- 5. Newman is placed on notice that commencement of operations under the certificate that is the subject of this resolution without complying with Ordering Paragraphs 3 and 4 may cause further suspension or revocation of his operating authority.
