RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO DENY ISSUANCE OF HIGHWAY CARRIER AUTHORITY, INCLUDING HOUSEHOLD GOODS CARRIERS NOT INVOLVING EXERCISE OF THE COMMISSION'S DISCRETIONARY AUTHORITY

Resolution 17981, dated March 9, 1977 which authorized the Executive Director the authority to deny the issuance of applications for highway carrier authority, including Household Goods Carriers is hereby rescinded.

In order to reduce paper work and relieve the Commission of its routine duties, the Executive Director is hereby authorized to deny permit applications or certificates where applicants fail to:

1. Pay regulatory fees and taxes owed as a prior holder.
2. File evidence of adequate public liability and property damage, workers' compensation, and/or cargo insurance.
3. Respond to requests for information.
4. Redeem unpaid checks submitted in payment of filing fees.
