RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR TO SUSPEND AND REVOKE OPERATING AUTHORITIES OF HIGHWAY CARRIERS, INCLUDING HOUSEHOLD GOODS CARRIERS, FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH STATUTORY PROVISIONS OR COMMISSION ORDERS

Resolution 18029, dated November 28, 1978 which authorized the Executive Director to take certain action is hereby rescinded.

By this resolution, the Executive Director is authorized to suspend and revoke the operating authorities held by highway carriers, including household goods carriers, for failure to:

1. File quarterly reports of gross operating revenue.
2. Pay Transportation Rate Fund Fees and/or Uniform Business License Taxes and/or penalties due thereon.
3. File evidence of adequate public liability and property damage, workers's compensation, and/or cargo insurance.
4. Respond to requests for information.
5. File special or Annual Financial Reports.
6. Pay a fine previously imposed for failure to respond to a request for information.
