## RESOLUTION CONCERNING PERMIT ACTION BY THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

Resolution 18030, dated November 28, 1978 which authorized the Executive Director to take certain permit action is hereby rescinded.

By this resolution, the Executive Director is authorized to issue, transfer, amend, place in voluntary suspension and reinstate permits of highway carriers, including household goods carriers, and approve authority to acquire or control any highway permit carrier, where applicants or permittees have met all statutory requirements and complied with all other orders, rules and regulations of this Commission.

The Executive Director is further authorized to reinstate revoked highway carrier permits including household goods carrier permits where such permits were revoked for failure to:

1. File quarterly reports of gross operating revenue.
2. Pay Transportation Rate Fund Fees and/or Uniform Business License Taxes and/or penalties due thereon.
3. File evidence of adequate public liability and property damage, workers's compensation, and/or cargo insurance.
4. Respond to requests for information.
5. File special or Annual Financial Reports.
6. Pay a fine previously imposed for failure to respond to a request for information.

The authority granted to reinstate revoked permits shall be exercised only upon payment of a fee \$125 for each permit to be reinstated and where all outstanding statutory and Commission requirements affecting the permit have been satisfied.
