R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION SUSPENDING THE HIGHWAY CONTRACT CARRIER PERMIT
OF ALLEN FORSYTH DBA P. F. FLYERS (T-151,223)
FOR FAILURE TO PASS CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL
VEHICLE SAFETY INSPECTION AND TERMINAL INSPECTION

Allen Forsyth dba P. F. Flyers (T-151,223) holds authority as a Highway Contract Carrier.

The California Highway Patrol (CHP) has statutory authority in the area of safety of Highway Permit Carriers under PU Code Section 3774(g).

The California Highway Patrol (CHP) has informed the Commission that it has performed three evaluation inspections of P. F. Flyers. All three inspections resulted in unsatisfactory ratings with vehicles being placed out-of-service for imminently hazardous mechanical defects each time. After each inspection Mr. Forsyth was advised of the requirement to comply, and of the consequences of continued noncompliance, including loss of operating authority. A warning letter was also sent informing him that his preventive maintenance program was unsatisfactory. Accordingly, the CHP has recommended suspension of his authority.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Highway Contract Carrier permit of Allen Forsyth dba P. F. Flyers (T-151,223) is suspended.
2. If Forsyth wishes to challenge the suspension he should file an application with the Commission's Docket Office, asking that his suspension be lifted and requesting a prompt hearing. (The Public Advisor's Office (telephone (415) 557-0890) is available to provide information about how to file an application.) Upon receipt of such an application, the Commission will set a hearing as soon as possible. Forsyth may also request reinspection by the California Highway Patrol.
3. Forsyth shall conduct no operations as a Highway Contract Carrier during the period of suspension.

4. The Executive Director may reinstate Forsyth's operating authority upon receipt of a written recommendation from the California Highway Patrol that his safety compliance warrants reinstatement, provided that his operating authority is not then suspended, or subject to suspension, for other reasons.
