R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION SUSPENDING THE HIGHWAY COMMON CARRIER CERTIFICATE  
AND HIGHWAY CONTRACT CARRIER PERMIT OF MICHAEL LISA TRUCKING, INC.  
FOR FAILURE TO PASS CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL VEHICLE SAFETY  
INSPECTION AND TERMINAL INSPECTION

Michael Lisa Trucking, Inc. (T-125,700) holds authority as a Highway Common Carrier and a Highway Contract Carrier.

The California Highway Patrol (CHP) has statutory authority in the area of safety of Highway Permit Carriers under PU Code Section 3774(g).

The California Highway Patrol (CHP) has informed the Commission that it has performed five evaluation inspections of Michael Lisa Trucking, Inc. All five inspections resulted in unsatisfactory ratings with vehicles being placed out-of-service for imminently hazardous mechanical defects each time. After each to the last three inspections the carrier was advised of the requirement to comply, and of the consequences of continued noncompliance, including loss of operating authority. A warning letter, informing the carrier of their unsatisfactory preventive maintenance program, was also sent. Accordingly, the CHP has recommended suspension of these operating authorities.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The Highway Common Carrier certificate and Highway Contract Carrier permit of Michael Lisa Trucking, Inc. (Lisa), T-125,700, are suspended.
2. If Lisa wishes to challenge the suspension they should file an application with the Commission's Docket Office, asking that the suspension be lifted and requesting a prompt hearing. (The Public Advisor's Office (telephone (415) 557-0890) is available to provide information about how to file an application.) Upon receipt of such an application, the Commission will set a hearing as soon as possible. Lisa may also request reinspection by the California Highway Patrol.
3. Lisa shall conduct no operations as a Highway Common Carrier or Highway Contract Carrier during the period of suspension.

4. The Executive Director may reinstate Lisa's operating authority upon receipt of a written recommendation from the California Highway Patrol that Lisa's safety compliance warrants reinstatement, provided that Lisa's operating authority is not then suspended, or subject to suspension, for other reasons.
