R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION VOLUNTARILY REVOKING CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC
CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY ISSUED TO HOT DOGGER TOURS, INC.
(PSC 1133).

Hot Dogger Tours, Inc. was authorized by Decision (D.) 92208, on September 3, 1980, in Application (A.) 59772, to operate as a passenger stage corporation. This authority provided a round-trip schedule leaving Los Angeles County on Friday evenings and returning from Mammoth Mountain Ski Resort on Sunday evenings during the winter ski season.

The Commission received a letter on March 6, 1992 from Michael B. Crosson, dba Hot Dogger Tours, Inc. requesting to cancel PSC 1133. Carrier is no longer operating for some time and does not intend to operate in the future.

IT IS ORDERED that:

The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between Los Angeles County and Mammoth Mountain Ski Resort granted by Decision (D.) 92208, on September 3, 1980 in Application (A.) 59772, is rescinded.
