RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION GRANTING GROUND SYSTEMS, INC., ROUTE REVISION DOCKET REQUEST TO ELIMINATE AND ADD A TERMINAL POINT ON ROUTE 10 PALM DESERT/PALM SPRINGS TO LAX

Ground Systems, Inc., (Petitioner) (PSC-5219) is a passenger stage corporation authorized to transport passengers and baggage between certain points in the Los Angeles Basin area and the Airports in that area.

Petitioner has filed a request with the Commission pursuant to the Commission's Route Revision Docket procedure for the revision of their passenger stage operating Route 10.

This request seeks to eliminate Denny's Restaurant, on Highway 111, Palm Springs as a terminal point. Petitioner alleges that it no longer has any patronage and does not necessitate a scheduled stop. The elimination of this stop would also reduce the total route mileage by nearly 4 miles on a round trip basis. In its place Petitioner requests the addition of a new terminal at Palm Springs Airport. At this terminal, Petitioner intends to interline with Desert Stage Lines whose passengers are mostly U.S. Marine Corps personnel destined for Ontario and Los Angeles International Airports.

Notice of this request appeared in the Commission's Daily Transportation Calendar on January 30, 1990. No protests were received.

The Commission has considered the request and finds that the following is justified and is hereby granted:

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Ground Systems, Inc., shall:

- File written acceptance of the certificate revision granted by this resolution within thirty days of the date of the resolution.
- 2. File tariffs and timetables reflecting the route revision authorized by this resolution; allow at least ten days' notice to the Commission and to the public, establish service on the same day that tariffs and timetables become effective.
