RESOLUTION RESCINDING CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC
CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY ISSUED TO KENNETH E. BAKE
DBA FREMONT COMMUTE SERVICE (PSC 1432)

Kenneth E. Bake dba Fremont Commute Service was authorized by Decision (D.) 88-12-923 dated December 9, 1988 in Application (A.) 88-04-055 to operate as a passenger stage corporation. Authority was granted to provide home-to-work service between points in Fremont and Hayward in Alameda County, on the one hand, and the United Airlines Maintenance Base at San Francisco International Airport in San Mateo County, on the other hand.

Applicant has not filed tariff, timetable, list of vehicles and a favorable California Highway Patrol safety inspection report.

IT IS ORDERED that:

The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a home-to-work service between points in Fremont and Hayward in Alameda County, on the one hand, and the United Airlines Maintenance Base at San Francisco International Airport in San Mateo County, on the other hand granted by Decision (D.) 88-12-023 on December 9, 1988, in Application (A.) 88-04-055 is rescinded.


