## RESOLUTION DENYING ISSUANCE OF HIGHWAY CARRIER AUTHORITY, INCLUDING HOUSEHOLD GOODS CARRIERS, FOR FAILURE TO SATISFY STATUTORY PROVISIONS OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE AND COMMISSION GENERAL ORDERS
