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RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION RESCINDING CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE
AND NECESSITY ISSUED TO KERNVILLE STAGE AND FREIGHT LINES
(PSC - 912).

Kernville Stage & Freight Lines holds a certificate of public convenience and necessity and is authorized to operate as a passenger stage corporation. Authority was granted to transport passengers between points in the State of California.

Resolution PE-1082 dated March 5, 1985 granted Kernville Stage & Freight Lines authority to voluntarily suspend their operation for one year. No request was received to extend the voluntary suspension. Thomas G. Bailey, President of Kernville Stage and Freight Lines contacted the Commission staff and indicated that he has not operated his business for several years.

Kernville Stage and Freight Lines failed to comply with the ordering paragraphs of Resolution PE-1082.

IT IS ORDERED that:

The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between points in the State of California be rescinded.
