
RESOLUTION DENYING ISSUANCE OF HIGHWAY CARRIER AUTHORITY, INCLUDING HOUSEHOLD GOODS CARRIERS, FOR FAILURE TO SATISFY STATUTORY PROVISIONS OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE AND COMMISSION GENERAL ORDERS

5. To comply with highway safety requirements.
