RESOLUTION RESCINDING CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE  
AND NECESSITY ISSUED TO VISION, INC., DBA HIGH  
DESERT SHUTTLE (PSC 6147)

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Vision, Inc., doing business as High Desert Shuttle was authorized by Decision (D.) 90-08-006 dated August 8, 1990 in Application (A.) 89-11-006 to operate as a passenger stage corporation between points in San Bernardino County on the one hand and Palm Springs, Ontario and Los Angeles Airports on the other hand. Authority was granted to provide on-call door-to-door service between points in San Bernardino County, Los Angeles International (LAX), Ontario (ONT), and Palm Springs Regional (PSP) Airports.

Applicant has not filed a letter of acceptance, tariffs, certificate of insurance and list of equipment to be used in their operation.

IT IS ORDERED that:


