R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION GRANTING BAY PORTER EXPRESS, INC.,  
ROUTE REVISION DOCKET REQUEST TO MODIFY ITS  
ROUTE 4 AND ROUTE 5.

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Bay Porter Express, Inc. (Petitioner) (PSC-1442) is a passenger stage corporation doing airport shuttle service to the airports of San Francisco, Oakland, and San Jose.

Petitioner proposes to eliminate 3 stops in its Route 4 and to add 2 stops to its Route 5.

Notice of this request appeared in the Commission's Daily Transportation Calendar on July 12, 1991. No protests were received.


