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RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION VOLUNTARILY REVOKING CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC
CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY ISSUED TO CAL PAC TRANSPORT
(PSC 0770).

Cal Pac Transport, Inc. was authorized by Decision (D.) 89-02-012 dated February 8, 1989 in Application (A.) 88-05-046 to operate as a passenger stage corporation. Authority was granted to transport passengers and baggage between points in San Diego, Orange, and Los Angeles Counties on one hand, and San Diego International Airport (SAN), Los Angeles International Airport (LAX), Orange County and Long Beach International Airport (LGB), on the other hand.

The Commission received a letter on February 14, 1992 from John C. Keegan, dba Cal Pac Transport, Inc. requesting a voluntary revocation of PSC 0770. Carrier went out of business on January 24, 1992 and has filed a Chapter 7 bankruptcy.

IT IS ORDERED that:

The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between points in San Diego, Orange, and Los Angeles Counties on one hand, and SAN, LAX, Orange County, and LGB on the other hand, granted by Decision (D.) 89-02-012 on February 8, 1989 in Application (A.) 88-05-046 is revoked.


