RESOLUTION

**RESOLUTION VOLUNTARILY REVOKING CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC
CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY ISSUED TO RAZ TRANSPORTATION
(PSC 5036).**

Raz Transportation was authorized by Decision (D.) 89-12-018 dated December 6, 1989 in Application (A.) 88-08-040 to operate as a passenger stage corporation. Authority was granted to transport passengers, baggage, mail and express over and along Oregon-California State Line and Crescent City, between the Oregon-California State Line north of Smith River and Santa Rosa, between the junction of U.S. Highway 101, West street, Healdsburg Avenue and the Alexander Valley bridge, and between Fort Bragg, Cloverdale and Leggett.

By letter dated January 10, 1992, R. J. Klingler, dba Raz Transportation requested voluntarily revocation of PSC 5036 because he has ceased operation and does not intend to resume the services in the future.

IT IS ORDERED that:


The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between the Oregon - California State Line and Crescent City, between the Oregon-California State Line north of Smith River and Santa Rosa, between the junction of U.S. Highway 101 West street, Healdsburg Avenue and the Alexander Valley bridge, and between Fort Bragg, Cloverdale and Leggett granted by Decision (D.) 89-12-018 on December 6, 1989 in Application (A.) 88-08-040 is revoked.
