RESOLUTION DENYING ISSUANCE OF HIGHWAY CARRIER AUTHORITY,  
INCLUDING HOUSEHOLD GOODS CARRIERS, FOR FAILURE TO SATISFY  
STATUTORY PROVISIONS OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE AND  
COMMISSION GENERAL ORDERS

1. Pay regulatory fees and taxes owed as a prior holder of authority.

4. Redeem unpaid checks submitted in payment of filing fees.
5. Comply with highway safety requirements.
