R E S O L U T I O N

RESOLUTION VOLUNTARILY REVOKING CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC
CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY ISSUED TO JANET LEE BOOKER
DBA ARNOLD SHUTTLE SERVICE (PSC 7077).

Janet Lee Booker was authorized by Decision 91-06-009 on June 5, 1991, in Application 91-01-017, to operate as a passenger stage corporation. The authority was granted to transport passengers and their baggage, on a scheduled basis, between Arnold on the one hand, and Murphys, Angels Camp, Sonora, Columbia, and Bear Valley on the other hand.

The Commission received a written request on April 7, 1992 asking that PSC 7077 be voluntarily revoked because the insurance is too costly for the amount of revenue generated.

IT IS ORDERED that:


The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between the City of Arnold on the one hand, and Murphys, Angels Camp, Sonora, Columbia, and Bear Valley on the other hand granted by Decision 91-06-009 on June 5, 1991 in Application 91-01-017 is revoked.
