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RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION VOLUNTARILY REVOKING CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC  
CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY ISSUED TO CHARLES E. ALLRED  
DBA YUBA-SUTTER AIRPORTER (PSC 6319).

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Charles E. Allred was authorized by Decision 90-05-023 on May 4, 1990, in Application 90-02-026, to operate as a passenger stage corporation. The authority was granted to transfer a passenger stage certificate of public convenience and necessity pursuant to Section 851 et seq. of the California Public Utilities Code. The decision granted authority to transport passengers and baggage on an on-call basis between the community of Sutter, the Cities of Live Oak, Marysville, Yuba City, and Wheatland, and Beale Air Force Base, on the one hand, and Sacramento Metropolitan Airport (SMA), on the other hand.

By letter dated May 18, 1992, Charles E. Allred, dba Yuba-Sutter Airporter (PSC 6319) indicated that he has ceased operation.

IT IS ORDERED that:


The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between the community of Sutter, the Cities of Live Oak, Marysville, Yuba City, and Wheatland, and Beale Air Force Base, on the one hand, and SMA, on the other hand, granted by Decision 90-05-023 on May 4, 1990 in Application 90-02-026 is revoked.
