RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION VOLUNTARILY SUSPENDING CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC
CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY ISSUED TO KOPECKY CORPORATION
(PSC 0813).

Kopecky Corporation was authorized by Decision (D.) 73203 dated October 17, 1967, in Application (A.) 49682, to operate as a passenger stage corporation. This authority provides transportation of passengers and their baggage between the cities of San Diego and San Bernardino, on the one hand, and Mammoth Mountain Recreation Area in the County of Mono, on the other hand. Decision (D.) 79078 dated August 24, 1971, in Application (A.) 52539 also authorized the carrier to provide service between San Diego, CA, Escondido, CA, and the Ontario Motor Speedway, Ontario, CA.

By letter dated August 7, 1992, Joann Kopecky, Chief Executive Officer on behalf of Kopecky Corporation requested authorization to suspend passenger stage corporation authority (PSC 0813). The carrier indicated that they intend to resume their operation in the near future, within a period of six months.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between the cities of San Diego, San Bernardino, on the one hand, and Mammoth Mountain Recreation Area in Mono County, on the other hand granted by Decision 73203 dated October 17, 1967 in Application 49682 and between San Diego, CA, Escondido, CA and the Ontario Motor Speedway in Ontario, CA granted by Decision 79078 dated August 24, 1971 in Application 52539 is hereby suspended until August 7, 1993.


2. Prior to resumption of service, tariff and timetable supplements cancelling the suspension supplements shall be filed. The required filing shall be made not less than five days notice to the public and to the Commission.
3. Comply with General Order 101-E by having on file evidence of insurance before you resume operation.
4. The authority to suspend operations granted herein shall expire on August 7, 1993, or upon earlier resumption of service which may be accomplished through compliance with ordering paragraph 2 above.
5. File quarterly report(s) of gross operating revenue and pay the required fees.
6. Kopecky Corporation is placed on notice that commencement of operations under the certificate that is the subject of this resolution without complying with Ordering Paragraphs 2, 3, 4 and 5 may cause further suspension or revocation of their operating authority.
