RESOLUTION DENYING ISSUANCE OF CHARTER-PARTY CARRIER AUTHORITY,  
HIGHWAY CARRIER AUTHORITY, AND HOUSEHOLD GOODS CARRIER  
AUTHORITY FOR FAILURE TO SATISFY STATUTORY PROVISIONS OF THE  
PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE AND COMMISSION GENERAL ORDERS
