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## RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION GRANTING VOLUNTARY SUSPENSION OF CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY ISSUED TO MICHAEL ANTHONY CARIGLINO AND KDF REYNOLDS, A PARTNERSHIP, DBA DESIGNATED DRIVER GROUP (PSC 7105).

Michael Cariglino and KDF Renolds, (carrier), a partnership doing business as Designated Driver Group were authorized by Decision 92-02-049 dated February 20, 1992 in Application 91-10-067 to transport passengers and their baggage on an "on-call" basis, between points in Alameda, Contra Costa and San Francisco counties on one hand, and San Francisco (SFO) and Oakland (OAK) International Airports, on the other hand.

By letter dated January 17, 1997, carrier requested voluntary suspension of their passenger stage authority (PSC 7105) effective February 6, 1997. Carrier indicated that it is not economically feasible to operate at the present time.

IT IS ORDERED that:

- The certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a passenger stage corporation between the points in Alameda, Contra Costa and San Francisco counties on one hand, and SFO and OAK International Airports, on the other hand, granted by Decision 92-02-049 dated February 20, 1992 in Application 91-10-067 is hereby suspended until February 6, 1998.
- 2. Prior to resumption of service, tariff supplements cancelling the suspension supplements shall be filed. The required filing shall be made on not less than five days notice to the public and to the Commission.

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- 3. The carrier shall comply with General Order 101-E by having on file evidence of insurance before resuming operations.
- 4. The authority to suspend operations granted herein shall expire on February 6, 1998 or upon earlier resumption of service, which may be accomplished through compliance with Ordering Paragraph 2 above.
- 5. The carrier shall file quarterly report(s) of gross operating revenue and pay the required fees during the suspension.
- 6. Michael Anthony Cariglino and KDF Reynolds, partners, dba Designated Driver Group are placed on notice that commencement of operations under the certificate that is the subject of this resolution without complying with Ordering Paragraphs 2, 3, 4 and 5 may cause further suspension or revocation of their operating authority.
