RESOLUTION DENYING ISSUANCE OF CHARTER-PARTY CARRIER AUTHORITY, HIGHWAY CARRIER AUTHORITY, AND HOUSEHOLD GOODS CARRIER AUTHORITY FOR FAILURE TO SATISFY STATUTORY PROVISIONS OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE AND COMMISSION GENERAL ORDERS

(NOTE: When the Governor signed AB 1683 on September 30, 1996, responsibility for the licensing of motor carriers of property, except household goods carriers, was transferred to the Départment of Motor Vehicles. However, as permitted by Vehicle Code Section 34605(b), the Commission is temporarily continuing to administer motor carrier licensing statutes as they existed on January 1, 1996, pursuant to a contract executed with the DNV.)

- Pay regulatory fees and taxes owed as a prior holder of authority.
- 2. File evidence of adequate public liability and property damage, workers' compensation, and/or cargo insurance.

- 4. Redeem unpaid checks submitted in payment of filing fees.

5. Comply with highway safety requirements.
